5. Engineer's report on Manor Police Station Building project.

Frank Phelan, City Engineer gave an update to Council on the Manor Police Station Building. He stated that the project was ahead of schedule.

6. Consideration, discussion and possible action on establishing a Capital Improvement Project Committee.

Motion to appoint City Engineer Frank Phelan, Interim City Manager Thomas Bolt, Public Works Director Mike Tuley, Mayor Jonse, Councilmember Burrell, and Councilmember Davies was made by Councilmember Hooker. Seconded by Councilmember Snowden. Vote: 6 For – 0 Against.

7. Consideration, discussion and possible action to conduct the First and Second Readings on the proposal to approve an ordinance granting to Atmos Energy corporation, a Texas and Virginia corporation, its successors and assigns, a franchise to construct, maintain, and operate pipelines and equipment in the City of Manor, Travis County, Texas, for the transportation, delivery, sale, and distribution of gas in, out of, and through said city for all purposes; providing for the payment of a fee or charge for the use of the public rights-of-ways; and providing that such fee shall be in lieu of other fees and charges, excepting ad valorem taxes; and repealing all previous gas franchise ordinances.

Motion to postpone until the March 18th meeting was made by Councilmember Burrell. Seconded by Councilmember Cruz. Vote: 6 For – 0 Against.

8. Consideration and possible action on a request for a variance from Ordinance 421, which establishes a safety zone for certain sex offenders.

Motion to deny the request for the variance was made by Councilmember Burrell. Seconded by Councilmember Cruz. Vote: 4 For – 1 Against, Councilmember Davies voted against and Councilmember Hooker abstained.

Motion to Adjourn made by Councilmember Burrell. Seconded by Councilmember Cruz. Vote 6 For – 0 Against. Meeting was adjourned at 7:35 P.M.
