

RESOLUTION NO. 2012-02

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MANOR, TEXAS SUSPENDING CITY ACTION ON THE NOTICE BY ATMOS ENERGY CORPORATION TO INCREASE GAS UTILITY RATES WITHIN ALL INCORPORATED AREAS SERVED BY THE MID-TEX DIVISION, WITH THE EXCEPTION OF THE CITY OF DALLAS, AND EXTENDING THE EFFECTIVE DATE OF THE PROPOSED RATES FOR A PERIOD OF NINETY (90) DAYS (FROM MARCH 6, 2012 TO JUNE 4, 2012).

WHEREAS, Atmos Energy Corporation has filed with the City of Manor (the City) a Statement of Intent to Increase Gas Utility Rates within All Incorporated Areas Served by the Mid-Tex Division, with the Exception of the City of Dallas; and

WHEREAS, this filing has been made pursuant to the provision of Texas Utilities Code, Section 104.102 and is intended to invoke the original jurisdiction of the City as provided in Texas Utilities Code, Section 103.003; and

WHEREAS, the proposed effective date of these rate changes is March 6, 2012 and this is a major rate change as defined by the Texas Utilities Code; and

WHEREAS, Atmos Energy Corporation, Mid-Tex Division (the Company) has requested the City pass a suspension resolution to extend the effective date of the proposed rates by 90 days to allow time to achieve an agreed resolution with the affected Cities; and

WHEREAS, the City of Manor desires this extension period to allow the City, City Coalition Attorneys, and Consultants time to review the filing and possibly achieve an agreed resolution with the Company.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MANOR, TEXAS, THAT:


The City of Manor will suspend City action on the proposed rate increase by Atmos Energy Corporation, Mid-Tex Division and agrees to extend the effective date of the proposed rates 90 days (from March 6, 2012 to June 4, 2012).
