



TRAVIS COUNTY BRIDGE 155 REPLACEMENT PROJECT

Travis County is proposing improvements to Bridge 155, which is located on Old Highway 20 just west of Manor, Texas. A new, two-lane bridge over Gilleland Creek will replace the existing one-lane bridge.

Old Highway 20 is a main route for access to the City of Manor, Highway 290 and Parmer Lane.

The improvements are designed to reduce safety issues for drivers and pedestrians who use the bridge. The upgrade will also

make it easier for emergency vehicles to drive on the bridge.

Construction funding for this project was approved by voters through the 2011 Travis County Bond Election.

The Bridge 155 Replacement Project is being developed in two phases:

Phase I: Bridge Design - COMPLETED

A team of engineers determined the best design for the new bridge based on anticipated traffic volumes and the existing

topography. The bridge design was completed in early Spring 2012.

Phase II: Construction

During construction, careful attention will be paid to avoid unnecessary delays and complete the project in a timely manner. A well-advertised detour route will be available for drivers to access US 290 and Parmer Lane.

Construction of a new two-lane bridge is anticipated to be completed by the end of 2012.
