Notes: Shadowglen & Presidential Meadows are in the Manor ETJ. Certificates of Occupancy are issued in Shadowglen but not in Presidential Meadows so residential totals in Presidential Meadows are based on platted lots. Prior to 2010 the residential multiplier was 2.8, after 2010 the multiplier is 3.21. 2020 population projections are based on extrapolating estimated 2010 - 2016 monthly averages over 48 months. There is only 1 multifamily development, with a residential impact of 50 people.
