NOTICE OF PEDDLER ORDINANCE REGULATIONS
(to be signed and attached to Original application)

Permit Required.

It is unlawful for any peddler to engage in business within the city without first obtaining a peddler's permit from the City Secretary as provided in City of Manor Ordinance 122-C, Section 2.

It is unlawful for any peddler to sell or solicit or take orders for or offer to sell or take orders within the limits of the city without having first obtained an appropriate permit authorizing the specific activity at such location as provided by Ordinance 122-C, Section 4.

Prohibited Conduct.

Any peddler who enters upon any premises and refuses to leave such premises, after having been notified or requested to leave by the owner, occupant or person in charge or control of such premises, shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor as provided by Ordinance 122-C, Section 5.

It shall be unlawful for any peddler to enter upon any private premise or to ring the doorbell or rap knock in any way in a manner calculated to attract the attention of the occupant when such premises are posted with a sign stating "no peddlers allowed" or "no solicitations allowed" or other words to such effect as provided by Ordinance 122-C, Section 6.

Hours of Operation.

It shall be unlawful for any peddler to engage in the business of peddling or soliciting within the city between the hours of 8:00 p.m. and 6:00 a.m. the following morning, or at any time on Sundays according to Ordinance 122-C, Section 7.
